






### **Overall Children in** Poverty 11%



### **Children in Poverty by Census Tract**







While <u>concerns</u> about violence are rising, La Crosse **County has seen decreases in number of assault-related** injuries, child abuse victims, bullying in schools, and youth exposure to sexual assault and dating violence.





83% of youth feel safe at school most of the time or always




In 2021 survey, youth experienced less bullying, exposure to violence at school, and intimate partner violence.




