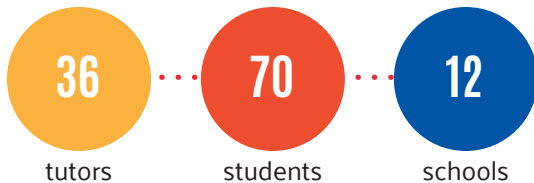


Participating teachers choose students who would benefit from the 1-on-1 attention
